Please join us on Saturday, October 19, 2019 at the Oakland Community College, Auburn Hills, MI Campus, for a one-day ceramics conference that will showcase the excellence of ceramic art and its diversity of techniques. This conference, Michigan Mud 2019, is brought to you in collaboration with the Michigan Ceramic Art Association (MCAA) and Oakland Community College. This biennial event is estimated to attract more than 200 ceramic artists ranging from high school to college students and hobby potters to established professionals. Michigan Mud offers attendees ample learning and networking opportunities throughout the day, with a featured keynote speaker, six presenters providing ceramic technique demonstrations, and a lecture. Michigan Mud 2019 is open to the public and features nationally-renowned ceramics artists, a student show, vendor tables, a presenter exhibition, and an after-hour closing reception at the Holding House Gallery. The MCAA is soliciting ceramic instructors to choose three students to submit work that best represents their program.

- The student show is a one-day show that comes down at the end of the conference.
- The keynote speaker, Julia Galloway, will present three categorical awards.
- Michigan Mud 2019 is open to both graduate students and undergraduate students.
- The student work must arrive with the following information:
 - Name, institution, year of study, description of piece, price, if applicable
- A label is provided on the next page of this invitation for submitted student work.
- MCAA will take a 20% commission of sales.
- Students can bring their work to the Oakland Community College, Auburn Hills Campus, Ceramic Department on Wednesday and Thursday, October 16-17, between the hours of 10 am - 5 pm, or on Friday, October 18, by appointment. - There is no charge for submitting pieces to the student show.
